Course content

This one day course explores the effectiveness of clear design communication, specifically through the use and development of colour rendering techniques.

Andrew Wilson looks first at how colour and clear graphic structure communicate ideas most efficiently. After reviewing drawing and line quality he will then demonstrate the effective use of colour pencil and colour pastel before inviting you to experiment and explore the techniques for yourself. There will be time to review and analyse your progress.

You are welcome to bring examples of your own work to the workshop but drawings for colour rendering will be supplied. You will need to bring the following:

Colour pencils – Caran D'Ache or similar, such as Derwent or Staedler. Water soluble pencils are best although we will not be using them with water. Ensure that you have a good range of greens, lemon or chrome yellow and a deep/rich blue.

Colour pastels – Carb Othello best in pencil form. Conte also do a good range or you could bring pastel sticks. Ensure that you have the greens, lemon yellows and deep/rich blue. These must be chalk pastels.

In addition, cotton buds and or cotton wool, a putty rubber, modelling knife to sharpen the pencils, a few sheets of tracing paper or detail paper, A3 in size.
